- 8. Any importer who sells or otherwise disposes of any potatoes imported by him shall forthwith notify the Director of Agriculture of the names and residences of the persons to whom the potatoes have been sold or disposed of and the quantity of potatoes so supplied to each person respectively.
- 9. Order in Council No. 1033 dated the 31st day of December, 1924, and published in the Cyprus Gazette of the 2nd of January, 1925, and Order in Council No. 1102 dated the 22nd day of March, 1926, and published in the Cyprus Gazette of the 26th of March, 1926, are hereby cancelled.
- 10. This Order shall take effect as from the 27th day of May, 1929.

- 2 There shall be charged a special fee, payable in addition to ordinary postage, late or registration fees, on any kind of postal packet, that is. letters, postcards, printed papers and commercial papers and samples, intended for transmission by the Desert Route (Service Transdesertique Syro-Iraquien Damas-Bagdad), at the rate of 3cp. per ounce or fraction thereof.
